Announcements

Our home group has tried to focus on the topic of *Service* over the past month with the IP's and Basic Text readings we've selected. In keeping with that topic we are looking for ways to tie in our format of literature study and sharing with the WSC's request for group input regarding the issues of collaboration, group conscience, supporting our (N.A.'s) vision, and the Traditions Book Project. We are still discussing ways in which we might be able to do that and what it might look like. A big concern of ours is how to focus on any of these issues, while still maintaining an atmosphere of recovery which would allow and encourage any addict to share whatever they need to. In other words, we want to have a meeting where addicts can read about and share about issues like group conscience or collaboration without it turning into a service meeting.

We are asking that the RSR, Area Chair, and any other interested member to please assist us by thinking about the idea in general and the concerns in specific, and then sharing their thoughts with us. Things like which piece of literature to read for a topic, possible speakers, whether or not to use any of the discussion forms found on-line from the WSC, etc.

In a way, this is our group's 1st attempt at a different level of collaboration with our ASC. Rather than our usual report consisting of how many addicts, how much money, and what we're doing next, we are asking for your direct input on how we, as a group, might be best able to fulfill our primary purpose and respond to our fellowship's requests for help at the same time.

Fellow Trusted Servants,

hose of you that know me on a more personal level know that due to my injuries that were caused from my active addiction, I needed to begin a new career shortly after becoming a member of Narcotics Anonymous; I'm eternally grateful to this program for teaching me how to receive an education and become an employable leader. I've been employed for the same company for past 8 years of my recovery and they have recently entrusted me to open a new facility in Minneapolis; which I graciously accepted. This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for me to pursue expediential growth in my field.

I'm flying out the weekend after Thanksgiving and predict that we can hire the staff needed, get them trained and operational by the end of January 2013; approximately 60 days. This will require me to miss at least 2 area meetings (maybe 3); and I'm asking this committee to allow me to have a leave of absence rather than step down.

This opportunity will allow me to develop my skills as a leader, which I plan to utilize upon my return to PASC as Area Vice Chair. I'm confident that the 5-6 months following my return will be ample time for me to learn, grow and align my knowledge in area service to run for the position of Phoenix Area Chair during the 2013/2014 calendar.

If there are other members that would like to step up and take my place; I will gladly show my appreciation of their willingness by humbly stepping down to give another member an opportunity to grow in our program.

The only regret I had for accepting this opportunity was my commitment I made to this committee and my recovery program, but then my Higher Power reminded me that it was because of my recovery program that I received this opportunity.

PHOENIX AREA RCMII Report December 1, 2012

Greetings fellow trusted servants, here is my report as the PASC RCMII:

- I attended my first Regional meeting as the PASC RCMII. The meeting was held on November 18, 2012.
- I read the Regional and Area guidelines for the RCMII service position.
- Please assure that anytime the NA logo is used the copyright or trademark symbols appear. This includes flyers, t-shirts, announcements and anywhere else we present our NA logos and NA symbols.
- I picked up and have delivered flyers for activities and events outside the Phoenix Area.
- The results of the recent GSR Assembly's issue discussion topics are in the Regional minutes from the November meeting. At the time of this meeting they have not been posted on the website but I have them with me, in print, if anybody would like to review them.
- I asked the RDs about releasing an agenda for the upcoming GSR assemblies and received a brush off answer that made little sense. I will reframe the question and re-introduce it at the next Regional meeting.
- The Regional Literature Review Committee is active again working on the text for the Twelve Tradition Workbook due to be presented at the next World Conference. They are seeking member input and participation in writing the text.
- ARCNA XXVII, held in Phoenix in 2012, contributed \$19,800.53 to the Regional treasury.
- There was discussion held in the Regional Forum that was based on incorrect subcommittee budget numbers. There were numbers presented on a display board during the Regional meeting that were also incorrect. The figures following are the budget numbers supplied by the Regional treasurer and voted on for approval. I have included the previous year's budget for comparison. All budgets were approved except the Administrative budget that was tabled for further review.

I will meet with her this week to give her those books as they have already been budgeted for the PR Subcommittee for 2012-2013.

There were 478 calls to the helpline in November. The accessline bill in November was \$97.76, and the Centurylink bill was \$60.13 for a total of \$157.89 or \$52.63 per area.

Now on to the important info. We lost our single most valuable resource for the helpline this month. Angela has decided to focus on other aspects of her recovery, and that has left behind a void that is hard to describe. Not only was she our vice-chair, EVA liaison, and acting secretary, she was instrumental in shaping our policy, keeping us on track, and setting the tone of our communications. She was also an avid volunteer, filling in on shifts that would otherwise leave calls unanswered. That's pretty much what's happening at this point - calls are going unanswered. Compounding Angela's absence on the Monday afternoon shift, we're also experiencing problems with at least one volunteer being unable to connect to the caller by pressing a key. I've added myself to that shift to see if I can reproduce the symptom this week.
